- People you don't even know!

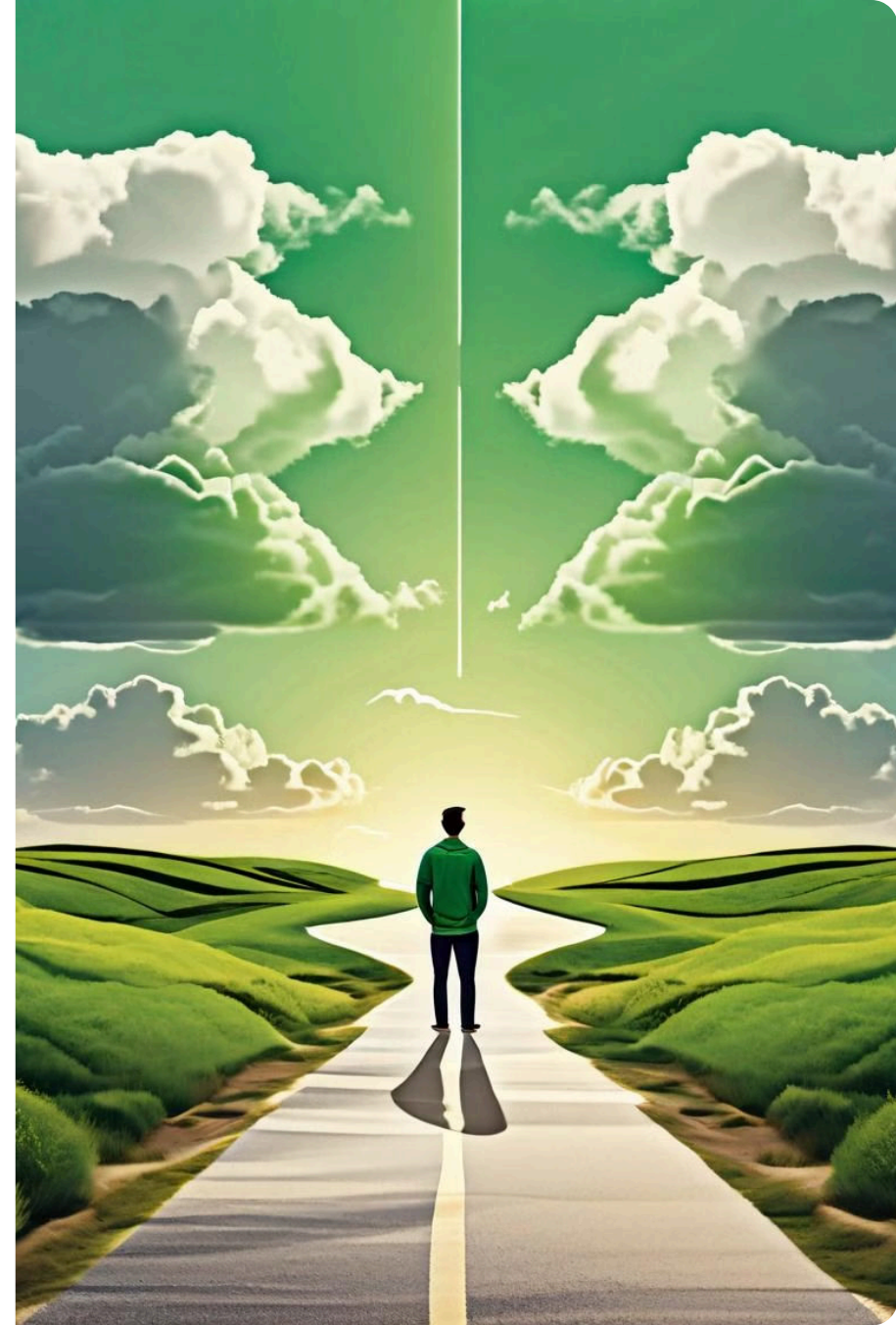
